

Getting To Know You Activities

Guess the Student

Students write one quirky or interesting thing about themselves on their piece of paper.

Collect the papers and read them out one by one.

The class then needs to guess who has written what.

What's the Truth?

On their piece of paper, students write 2 things about themselves that are true and one thing that is not (i.e. 'I have never been on a plane or I like chocolate ice cream etc). In groups of 6 - 8, students take it in turns to read their 3 sentences. The other students then try to guess what is true and what is not.

All About Me Shield

Students write and draw information in each separate section.

Suggestions are:

- their family
- their favourite hobby
- their favourite holiday
- a self portrait
- what they would like to be when they are older

Getting to Know You Bingo

Students go around the classroom, talking to each other to complete the grid.

They can only use a students name ONCE. Every box needs to be filled in.

2 blank templates are also included for you to make your own.

All Tied Up

In groups of 6-8, students stand in a circle.

They all place one hand in the centre and hold someone else's hand.

Next, they place their other hand in the centre of the circle and hold onto someone else's hand.

Now without releasing any hands, try and untangle the group so that no hands are crossed.

This can be done by turning, twisting or going over and under two joined hands. Promotes communication and teamwork.

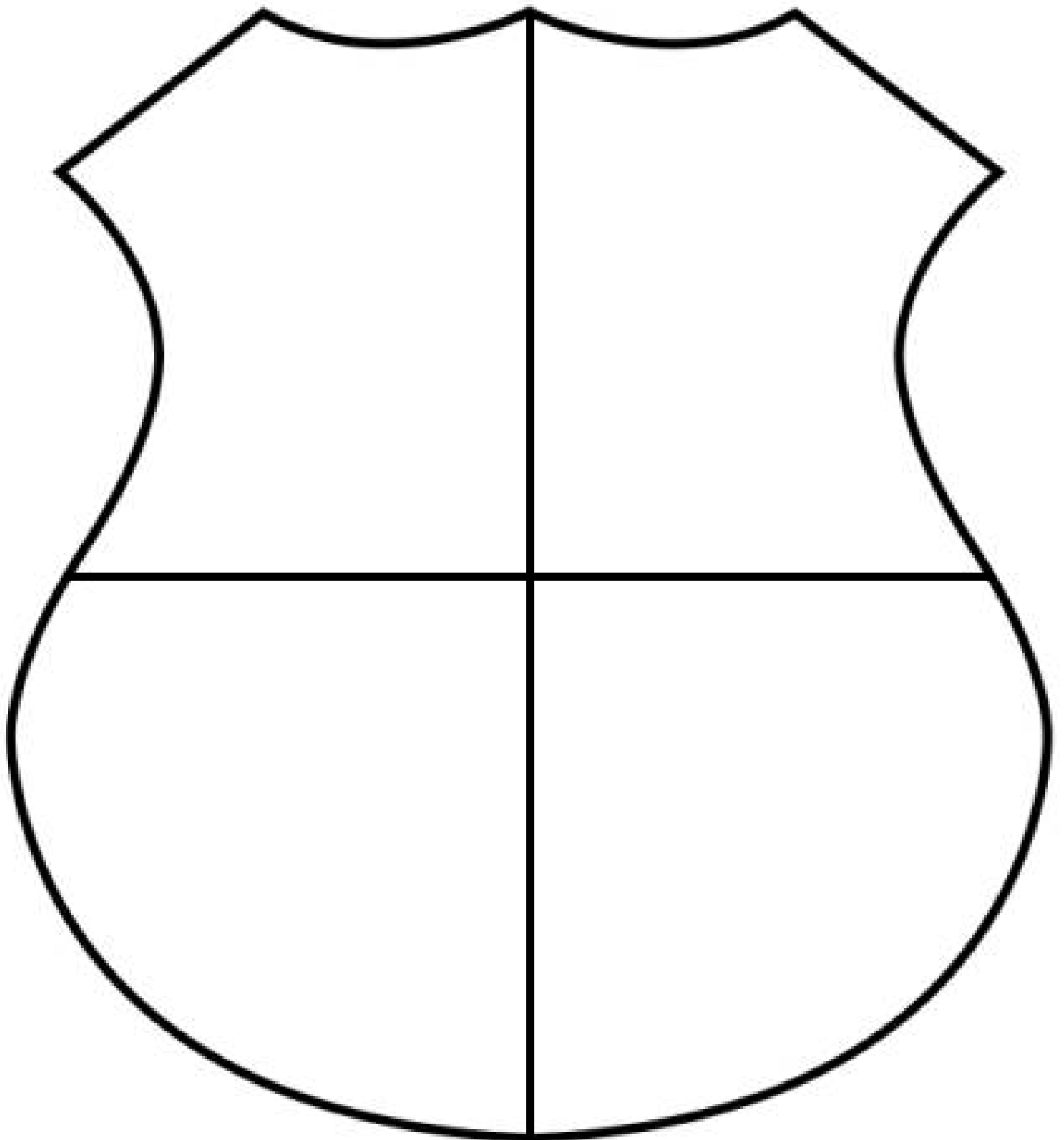
